第4問 次の英文を読んで、 から の空所に、それぞれ下の1)～4)の中から最も適切なものを1つずつ選んで入れ、文脈が通るようにしなさい。

People can only guess where human beings first on the earth. In this case, *guessing* means drawing a conclusion from all the facts that can be found. The conclusion may fit the known facts, but it cannot be proved by the evidence. A commonly accepted conclusion is that Asia is the birthplace of humans.

There are facts that support this conclusion. People may have from an apelike ancestor common to humans and other primates. The lands where animals have developed over thousands of years have had mild climates, various kinds of landscapes, and enough, but not too much, food.

At a in time, a few million years before humans appeared, there was a vast plateau in northern Asia. The climate there was cold nor tropical. When not searching for food, animals would not have just rested all of the time. They would have been roving around because new of food would have to be found. On this plateau, there were forests, plains, and open land. Some of these places had of rain. Others were deserts. Many of the plants were good to eat, and there was plenty of game.

The very earliest humans probably on the floor of the forests. There they could use the trees as shelters. Those who ventured onto the plains had to be alert to the floods and sandstorms that caught and preserved so many animals. Ability to escape provided for future generations, but left no evidence of the past.

There were primates in Asia before the records of humans. The primates were different from the primates and humans of today, but they could have been the ancestors of either or both.

The first of the human creatures was found in Asia, and the greatest number of possible ancestors was also found there. Asia seems a probable homeland for

humanity.
