In almost every sense that the 19th century was the railroad age, the 20th century has been the automobile age. Henry Ford's determination to sell a car to everyone nearly succeeded. He and his competitors were making so many that by as early as 1923 the automobile had replaced iron and steel as the most **21** American commodity. Paved roads, begun in response to the bicycle lobby, **22** to the point where the nation seemed likely to become one big parking lot. Buses replaced trolley cars for urban transit; trucks and highway buses passed the railroads and **23** their existence.

Even more than the railroad, the automobile had a profound cultural impact. The mobility it provided freed workers to seek the best jobs regardless of their **24**. Thus loyalty to company and community was gradually replaced by a search by car for the highest available income. Some cars expressed luxury; all cars expressed taste. Not to have a car was to be somehow fatally exiled from American culture. Foreign audiences were astonished to see poor farmers **25** the Dust Bowl in their cars and trucks, as depicted in the film version of John Steinbeck's "Grapes of Wrath." To Americans, this seemed only **26**.

According to surveys of American society many families would go without indoor plumbing and cut down on food in order to **27** a car. Young people found the auto a sure way to escape **28** supervision. For a while the "Sunday drive" in the newly polished sedan became an American institution. By the '60s Americans were becoming so reluctant to leave their cars that many businesses were adapting to the concept of drive-in service. Banks and restaurants learned to **29** customers through the car window. Huge lots became drive-in movie theaters where hundreds of sound speakers made each car a miniature theater facing a giant screen. In California there are **30** drive-in churches.
